

STAR Role Model Confidentiality Agreement

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA), a Federal law, requires that Corsicana ISD, with certain exceptions, obtain a parent/guardian's written consent prior to the disclosure of personally identifiable information about their child's education records. We have obtained consent to release student education records to the assigned role models and to STAR.

However, according to FERPA, a role model may be given the right by the parent/guardian to have access to the student record, but under no circumstance is the role model allowed to release or share student records with a "third party." Student records may only be shared with the school district, the parent/guardian, and/or student, and consent has been granted to the role model and STAR. Anyone else is considered a third party.
